- 1' [...] the moon being [...] low to the south [...]
- 2' [...] gusty [...] and] west winds blew. The 7th, Mercury [...]
- 3' [... Night of the 8th, beginning of the night, the moon was] 3 cubits [in front of β / δ]
Scorpii, [it stood] $2 \frac{2}{3}$ cubits in front of Mars [to the west ...]
- 4' [... Night of the 9th, beginning of the night, the moon was] $\frac{1}{2}$ cubit [...] α Scorpii, the
moon being 8 fingers high to the north. Around [...]
- 5' [...] Mars was 8 fingers below δ Scorpii. The 10+[xth, ...]
- 6' [...] moonrise to sunset: $3^{\circ} 30'$, measured (despite) mist; when the moon came out, more
than [...]
- 7' [...] in its eclipse, the 'garment of the sky' was there; in [its] eclipse, [...]
- 8' [... x]+ $\frac{1}{2}$ cubit below β Capricorni, [(the moon) having passed] $\frac{1}{2}$ cubit to the east, [it
became eclipsed]
