- 2' [...] low to the south. The 4th, equinox; I did not watch [...] .... [...]
- 3' [... x]+1 cubits. Night of the 8th, beginning of the night, the moon was 1 cubit in front of  $\alpha$  Leonis, the moon being 4 fingers [...]
- 4' [... Night of the 10th, beginning of the night, the moon was]  $\frac{1}{2}$  cubit [above]  $\beta$  Virginis, the moon having passed a little to the east, [it stood]  $2+[x$  cubits] behind Saturn [to the east ....]
- 5' [... Mercury] was  $\frac{2}{3}$  cubit below  $\eta$  Tauri. The 12th, moonset to sunrise:  $2^\circ$ . Around the 12th, Jupiter's acronychal rising [...]
- 6' [...] sunset to moonrise: [ $nn^\circ$ ], measured (despite) clouds. Night of the 15th, last part of the night, the moon was 4 cubits above  $\alpha$  Scorpii [...]
- 7' [... Saturn] became stationary [...] behind  $\sigma$  Leonis. Ni[ght ....]
- 8' [...] Jupiter was in Libra; Venus, in the beginning of the month, was in Aqua[rius ....]
