

## Übersetzung des Keilschrifttextes 142B

B:

Upper edge

1 At the command of Bel and Beltija may it go well.

Obv.

1 Year 169, month IX, the 1st (of which followed the 30th of the preceding month), sunset to moonset: 17°?, measured (despite) mist.

2 Night of the 1st, all night clouds were in the sky, the north wind blew.

3 The 1st, clouds were in the sky, the north wind blew. Night of the 2nd, clouds were in the sky;

4 the moon was 2 ½ cubits above Venus, the moon having passed ½ cubit to the east.

5 The 2nd, thin clouds were in the sky; at noon, the sun was sur[rounded by a ha]lo.

6 Night of the 3rd, clouds were in the sky; the moon was 2 cubits behind β Capricorni,

7 the moon being 1 cubit low to the south. The 3rd, thin clouds were in the sky;

8 at noon, the sun was surrounded by a halo which was [not] closed.

9 Night of the 4th, beginning of the night, the moon was 2 [...] above<sup>sic</sup> γ

10 Capricorni,

Lower edge

1 the moon being 2 ½ cubits high<sup>sic</sup> to the north;

2 all night clouds were in the sky, the north wind blew.
