1 [Month I³,] night of the 29th, first part of the night, Venus

2 was $\frac{2}{3}$ cubit [below] Jupiter.

Obv.

1 Year 142, kings Antiochus and Antiochus, his son.

2 Month II, (the 1st of which was identical with) the 30th (of the preceding month), sunset to moonset: 16° ; measured (despite) clouds; it was low to the sun.

3 Night of the 2nd, clouds were in the sky; the moon stood $1\frac{1}{2}$ cubits in front of Venus to the west, it stood $1\frac{1}{2}$ cubits in front of Jupiter to the west,

4 4 cubits above Mercury. Night of the 3rd, the moon was 2 cubits in front of β Geminorum. Night of the 4th, the moon was 2 cubits in front of

7 δ Cancri.

8 Night of the 5th, the moon was 3 cubits below ϵ Leonis,

9 the moon being $\frac{1}{2}$ cubit back to the west.
