Obv.

- 1 Month XII<sub>2</sub>, the 1st (of which followed the 30th of the preceding month), sunset to moonset: 19°;
- 2 it was bright, earthshine,  $\frac{1}{2}$  cubit in front of Mercury,
- 3 the moon being 1 cubit low to the south.
- 4 Night of the 1st, very overcast. The 1st, in the morning,
- 5 clouds crossed the sky, rain DUL,
- 6 it thundered slowly once, twice, thrice,
- 7 the south wind blew;

## Lower edge

1 all day very overcast.

## Rev.

1 Night of the 2nd, the moon was  $3 \frac{1}{2}$  cubits in front of  $\eta$  [Tauri.]

2 The 2nd, clouds [...]

3 in the afternoon, clouds were in the sky. Night of the 3rd,

4 the moon was  $1 \frac{1}{2}$  cubits behind  $\eta$  Tauri, the moon

5 being 2 cubits low to the south. The 3rd, all day

6 very overcast, the south wind blew; in the afternoon,

7 a little rain shower.

8 That month, the river level

9 receded . . . cubits, total: 17 was the *na* (gauge).
